

Camping trailer boat

If you're looking for a camping trailer and you'd also rather like a boat, you'd normally have a dilemma: you can't tow both. Now, though, a product has been launched that is both camping trailer and boat. The Ezyboat folds for towing; wheels descend from the hull at the push of a lever - and there's ample space inside for tent and other camping equipment including a cool box. This is a truly amazing piece of camping gear.

It folds in half laterally; one person can do this but it's easier with two. Made in Poole in the Sunseeker boatyard, and comprising all-British products, it is launched later this spring.

The Ezyboat weighs 750kg and can carry a load of 150kg (this figure includes its engine - allow 50kg for a 15hp engine, for example).

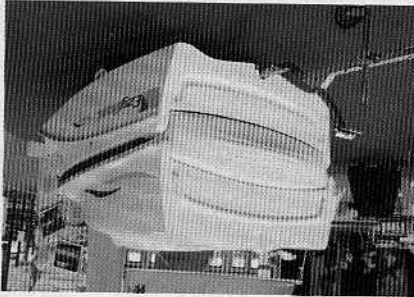
It's light enough to be towed by a small car and is also ideal for towing behind motorhome.

The basic boat price is £7950 - and you can choose from a number of options, depending on how you want to use the trailer-boat.

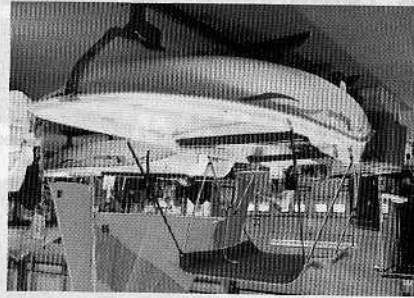
It's designed for a variety of uses from fishing to cruising to sailing to towing rubber fun-rings. There's a choice of engines from 2.5hp (£660) to 25hp (£3000). Other options include a canopy at £399 and a complete sail kit (£1490).

The retractable wheels allow you to reverse the boat into the water; it remains on its trailer so avoiding the usual struggle involved in getting a boat back onto its trailer after a sail.

The Ezyboat in camping-trailer mode

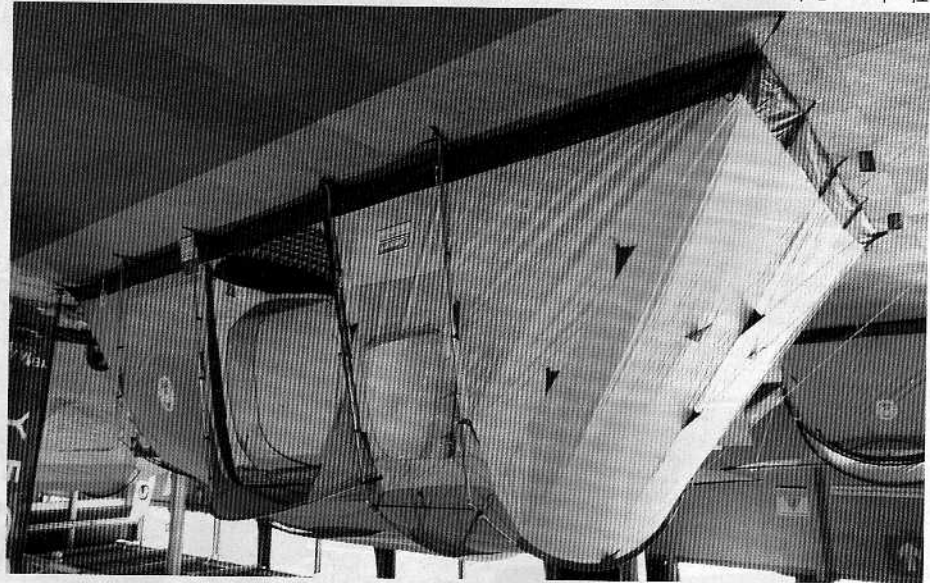


The Ezyboat in camping-trailer mode

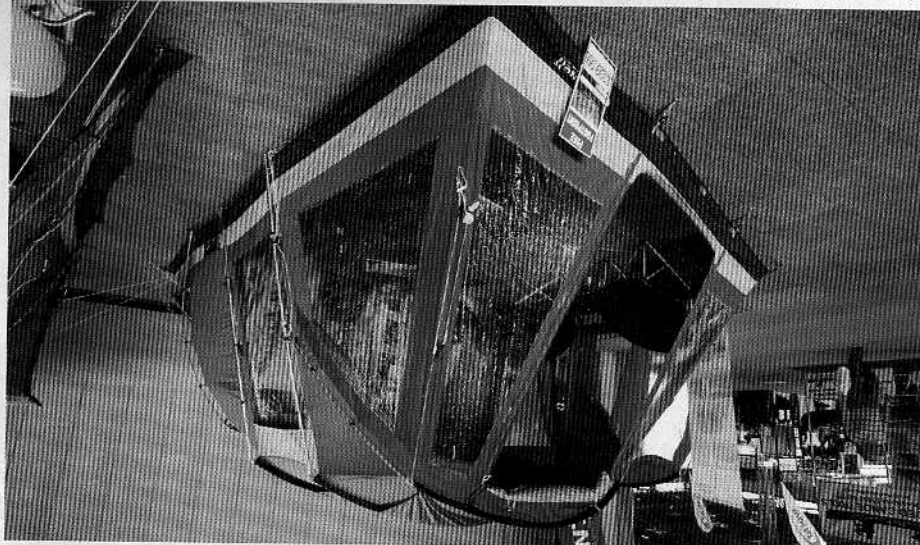

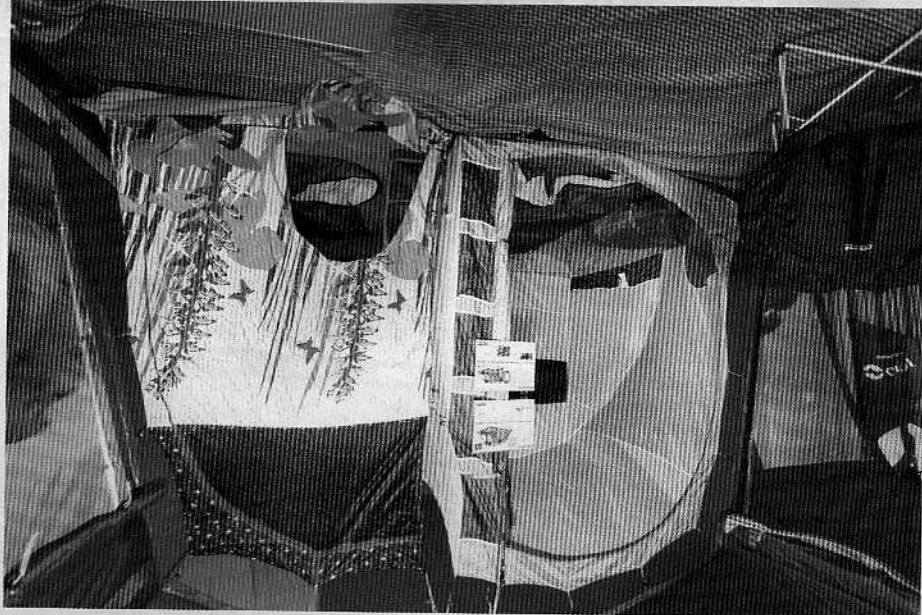
